

Dear parents, carers and students,

Record Breaking Examination Results!

One of the highlights of my summer were the results days for Year 13 and Year 11, with both year groups breaking all previous school records!

Year 13 students left having achieved the following:

- 64% of Year 13 students left Sherburn High School with 3 A levels graded at A* B
- 100% of A level Chemistry, Physics, Media and Photography students achieved A* B
- 70% of A level Geography students achieved A* B
- 94% of A level maths students achieved A* B

And the list of outstanding outcomes in subjects goes on!

These brilliant results meant 80% of applicants got into their first-choice university including Newcastle, LSC, Warwick and Durham. LSC and Durham.

We also have students who were successful in obtaining highly competitive apprenticeships in sectors such as accounting, National Rail project management and computing. And of course, some young people entering the world of work or taking a gap year before starting their studies.

Year 11 students also did incredibly well with early indications from FFT Aspire for Progress 8 giving us a Progress 8 score of +0.57, which is truly incredible. The table below further demonstrates our students' fantastic achievement
